

Triple Play Sportsplex - Phase Two Re-Opening Protocol

We are re-opening Triple Play safely and responsibly by adhering to the State of Texas Governor's orders and CDC guidelines. Phase Two re-opening will start on Monday, May 18th and is expected to extend at least May 30. Our Phase Two re-opening will include team field practices, individual lessons and indoor facility use for individual/team rentals as well as limited walk in traffic following the protocol outlined below. **ALL PARTICIPANTS RECONIZE AND ASSUME ALL RESPONSIBILITY TO STAY SAFE**

- Our business hours will be Mon - Fri 3:00 pm - 8:00 pm, Sat 10:00 am - 2:00 pm, Sun 1:00 pm - 6:00 pm.
- Senior hour will be Mon - Fri from 3:00 pm - 4:00 pm with only 55 year and older allowed to enter the building. All seniors will be allowed to use the auto machine cages for \$5 during this hour.
- We will be open to the general public on a restricted basis as we are only running at 25% capacity.
- The only people allowed to stay inside during team practices will be player hitting groups (maximum of 4 per group) with their coach.
- The auto machine cages will be available for rent only at the rate of \$10 for 10 minutes or \$25 for 30 minutes. No tokens will be issued.
- The fitness facility will remain closed.
- Team practices must adhere to the following:
 - . All activities are limited to a maximum of 4 players
 - . Teams may setup a maximum of 3 stations per field: infield, left field, right field
 - . No hitting stations in the outfield grass
 - . Each player group may rotate to various stations but groups must stay the same for the duration of the practice and each group should maintain social distancing guidelines
 - . The dugouts should not be used and at no time should the entire team come together
 - . Parents are allowed to remain outside around the fields during practice but should maintain strict social distancing guidelines at all times
 - . Teams should remain in the parking lot until their practice time starts and should leave the premise as soon as the practice ends

All teams and participants will be responsible for following these protocols as well as the recommendations and guidelines put out by both the State of Texas Governor's Order as well as the CDC. We appreciate all of our customers and employees and want to make sure we re-open as safely as possible. If anyone remains uncomfortable in this environment they should absolutely refrain from attending until they feel it is safe to do so.
